

QoL Recruiting & Transfer Guidelines



Introduction

The mission of QoL is to be the ultimate relationship partner for successful, independent, client-focused groups and their producers. The following Recruiting & Transfer Guidelines set the Company's approach to its involvement in the recruiting of downline Agents or Agencies to ensure a level of consistency in treatment for all MGA distribution partners.

Commission Level Guidelines for Commissionable Agent/Agency Contracts

Below are the commission level contracts available to QoL MGAs downline Agents and Agencies:

- **Level 01-11: Street level compensation at MGA's discretion**
- Level 12*: \$100,000 production requirement (net annualized weighted premium)
- Level 13*: \$150,000 production requirement (net annualized weighted premium)
- Level 14*: \$200,000 production requirement (net annualized weighted premium)

*Levels 12-14 require an Agent Commitment and Profile (Form #AGLC111336) and is subject to Corebridge management approval.

- Agent Commitment and Profile
(Form #AGLC111336 required for Over Street Levels)
- Annualization Form (if applicable)

Requirements for Consideration of Transfer**

Corebridge will consider the request of an active Agent or Agency to transfer from one MGA hierarchy to another if they provide one (1) of the following options:

- Unconditional Release Form (Form #AGLC202217) from current MGA, or a reasonable notification in writing, from the existing MGA with a copy to Corebridge via email to getappointed2@corebridgefinancial.com; or
- Voluntary Termination Notice (Form #AGLC202218) at least six (6) months prior to the desired effective date of transfer, or a reasonable notification in writing, to the existing MGA with a copy to Corebridge via email to getappointed2@corebridgefinancial.com; or
- The Agent/Agency has not written business within the prior six (6) months and has no pending applications.
- The Agent/Agency and current MGA provide mutually agreed upon terms to QoL via email to getappointed2@corebridgefinancial.com

**The commission level for any active Agent or Agency will remain unchanged for a six (6) month period following any transfer.

Attempts to bypass or circumvent these guidelines may result in immediate termination.
